TODAY'S SPEAKER

Frank Paladino RightComm LLC

Frank started his current business 3 years ago and it's doing great.

Frank comes from the Utica area and attended RIT. After graduating his first job was at a department store in Rochester, where he was the assistant buyer of women's shoes. He received an offer to sell computers for another company. PCs were just coming out at the time, and although he knew nothing about computers, he accepted the offer. He did that in Syracuse from around 1985-90. Around that time he also became a Mac expert. Apple was a young company that gave incentives to sellers. Frank scored a sale of 40 Macs, earning a bonus of \$4000.

In the 90s the cellular business was beginning. Frank worked at a Cellular One in Rochester for 7 years.

In 1997 Frank got married and moved to NY city, where he started a family and worked for a software company that was putting presentations on CDs. Frank was able to get accounts with many of the major banks and did well.

Frank and his family left NY after 911 and he moved to the Capital Region. He worked for TW Cable from 2008 to 2020. He then decided to start his own business helping businesses get connectivity. He mostly works with IT vendors and helps businesses to figure out their needs and set up their services. He can help any size business with internet service and telecommunications.
